





1. Please describe the purpose and intent of the grant.

The Canoga Park Women's Club was founded in 1914. Our clubhouse, built in 1929, is located on the corner of Jordan Ave and Valerio St in Canoga Park. We have to remove two Mexican Palm trees that are growing very close to our building and interfering with our foundation. We want to protect our historic clubhouse. We are also trimming a California Sycamore tree, per state regulations a protected tree, on our lot.

2. How will this grant be used to primarily support or serve a public purpose and benefit the public at-large? (Grants cannot be used as rewards or prizes for individuals)

The Canoga Park Women's Club is a volunteer philanthropic organization. Our purpose is to become a center for community endeavors, to work hand in hand for social welfare, and for the general advancement of both Club and community. Our clubhouse is used by local organizations, such as: SFV Iris Society, AA, three local square dancing groups, a Networking organization, and Canoga Park/West Hills Republican Women, among others. Our facility is available for rent to the community for private parties and events. Some examples of our club philanthropic activities are: establishment and continued support of Haven Hills Domestic Violence Shelter, Canoga Owensmouth Historical Society, and Friends of the Canoga Park Library. We have a yearly "swap meet" for Haven Hills clients so they can pick out slightly used clothing and kitchen items they might need and take things for free. We have a yearly Veteran's Luncheon for community vets and their wives. We also support both monetarily and with hands on service: Scholarships for CP High School, West Valley Food Pantry, Guadalupe Center, Urban Promise, Pet Adoption Fund, Salvation Army Adult Rehab, Ambassador Gardens Retirement Center, Owensmouth Continuation High School, and Miller Career and Transition Center.


